- Ensure a respectful and inclusive tone while handling sensitive topics
- Coordinate with the editing team to review audio and publish episodes
- Monitor listener feedback and incorporate insights to improve future content
- Share episodes across platforms and contribute to digital promotion strategy

Qualifications

- Demonstrated interest in human rights, social justice, public storytelling, or a related field.
- Prior experience with hosting, public speaking, or interviewing (professional or volunteer)
- Strong communication skills and comfort speaking on sensitive topics with empathy
- Basic knowledge of podcast recording tools and remote audio platforms
- Ability to collaborate in a virtual, fast-paced, start-up nonprofit environment
- Editorial judgment and a thoughtful approach to representation and inclusion
- Experience with Canva, Wix, or content management systems is a plus
- Familiarity with audio editing tools and podcast publishing platforms preferred
